Welcome to the Lyrico Youth Choirs Association!

This organization has been in existence since 1984, and currently operates an auditioned Junior Choir and Senior Choir for students residing in Strathcona County and surrounding areas. This year we have also launched a non-auditioned adult choir for anyone 18+ called Friends of Lyrico.

The choirs exist to enrich the musical experience of gifted amateur singers and are funded in part by membership fees, fundraising, and contributions from both local and provincial arts funding organizations. This handbook is designed to prepare singers and their parents for the coming year of music-making, and to answer some frequently asked questions.

MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Lyrico Youth Choirs (formerly Elk Island Regional Honor Choirs Association) is to promote excellence in musical education by establishing and maintaining a choir or choirs composed of gifted and interested children selected from students residing in Strathcona County and surrounding areas in the province of Alberta.

All of the choristers are auditioned and consist of some of the finest young singers in this area. There is some overlap between the choirs to accommodate singers of varying maturity and experience level. REGISTRATION AND FEES

Fee Information and Payment Policy

Registration fees are established by the Volunteer Executive and are reviewed annually. Registration fees represent less than half the full cost of a singer's participation in the choir. Additional funding is provided through operating grants and occasional special funding (concert ticket sales, casino, silent auction, raffle tickets, sponsorships, 50/50 tickets, etc.)

Our registration form can be found on the Lyrico website (www.lyricoyouthchoirs.com), or a paper copy can be obtained. The full registration fee is due no later than September 30, 2026, unless a two month payment plan has been arranged. Any fees received after September 30 may be subject to a \$25 late penalty fee. Payment options include cash, cheque or e-transfer. Cheques should be made out to the Lyrico Youth Choirs Association.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to include your chorister's name in the information section so our bookkeeper knows whose account to apply the funds to.

In the event of unforeseen circumstances, please contact the Choir Manager. Failure to contact the Choir Manager on or before September 30th may result in the temporary suspension or expulsion of the Choir member from the Choir.

A \$25.00 NSF charge will apply to any dishonored cheques. Lyrico Youth Choirs reserves the right to insist upon full fee payment in the event any cheque is returned.

\$500.00 (paid deposit will be applied & balance due Sept 30)

- Included in the annual fee is a digital copy of our yearly choir photo.

SENIOR CHOIR

\$550.00 (paid deposit will be applied & balance due Sept 30)

Music Deposit \$50.00 (postdated cheque dated June 1, 2027)

- Included in the annual fee is a digital copy of our yearly choir photo and a partial subsidy for the overnight trip to Camp Nakamun.
- Costs for special trips and/or retreats are not included in annual fees unless specified.

You will be informed of any additional activity or retreat costs once they have been confirmed.

The Wittenberg Scholarship

The Wittenberg family set up The Wittenberg Scholarship in honour of their daughter, Stephanie, who was killed in a tragic car accident. Stephanie was a member of our choir who loved music and singing. In her memory, the scholarship is used to fully or partially offset the cost of registration for families who may have difficulty paying. Thank you to the family for sharing Stephanie’s love for music through this annual scholarship in her name. Please contact the Choir Manager for more scholarship information. Applications for funding are reviewed by the Board. **The cut-off date is September 30 of each year.** A Board member will contact you directly with the decision.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

All choir membership refunds are pro-rated over a period of 9 months (September – May). Reimbursement of remaining fees will take effect the 1st day of the following month after cancellation notification was given (please refer to below scenarios). All refunds are subject to a \$50 processing fee. **There will be no refunds beyond October 31.** (Note: Extenuating circumstances will be considered by the Board on a case-by-case basis)

Example: “Kelly” withdraws from choir on Oct 12 and “Jennifer” withdraws on Oct 31. They are each considered to have been in the choir September and October and receive 7/9’s of their registration fees back. (i.e. A senior choir registration of \$550 would receive a refund of \$427.78 minus the \$50 processing fee for a total refund of \$377.78).

Attendance Policy

- ❖ **It is very important that choir members attend regularly, since a choral rehearsal teaches not only the music, but blends the sounds of the singers over time.** Singers or parents are expected to notify their director in advance for any planned absences from rehearsals or performances. In the event of an unplanned absence (illness or emergency) singers or parents must notify their director as soon as possible
- ❖ **If any member misses more than two rehearsals without proper notification, their membership will be reviewed.** We realize that singers are talented and often very busy people. Arrangements can be discussed with the Directors to accommodate sports or other arts activities that might otherwise prevent someone from being part of the choir or from attending regular rehearsals.

Behavior Policy

- ❖ Disruptive or rude behavior will not be tolerated.
- ❖ **FIRST offence-** a verbal warning will be given.
- ❖ **SECOND offence-** the parents will be notified.
- ❖ **THIRD offence-** membership will be reviewed, with the chance of the choir member being suspended or expelled from the choir.

EXPECTATIONS

Choristers:

As a choir member I understand that:

- ☐ I am an ambassador for Lyrico Youth Choirs and am expected to show pride in the choir.
- ☐ I will accept my placement in the choir and make every effort to participate in all rehearsals and performances.
- ☐ I will notify the Director in advance for any planned absences from rehearsals or performances. In the event of an unplanned absence (illness or emergency), I will notify the director as soon as possible.
- ☐ I will show respect for my fellow choir members, the Director, Accompanist, Manager, and Supervisors.
- ☐ I will exercise self-disciplined behavior at all times during rehearsals and performances.
- ☐ I will adhere to the choir attendance policy and always give my best effort.
- ☐ **I will make my parents aware of all Choir newsletters and/or other printed information received at rehearsal or from the website (www.lyricoyouthchoirs.com)**

- ☐ Failure to comply with the above expectations could jeopardize my participation in the choir.
- ☐ **All choristers are to treat their choir folder and its contents with respect. All items given to the choristers are expected to be returned in excellent condition.**

Parents:

As a parent of a choir member I understand that:

- ❖ I am responsible to ensure that my child has transportation to and from all rehearsals, performances and festivals, paying due attention to drop-off and pick-up times.
- ❖ I am responsible for notifying the Director in advance for any planned absences for my child. In the event of an unplanned absence (illness or emergency), I will notify the director as soon as possible.
- ❖ I am to attend the Annual General Meeting on Monday, October 5, 2026.
- ❖ **I am to check the website (www.lyricoyouthchoirs.com) on a regular basis for updated choir information and read all choir emails and newsletters received by my child.**
- ❖ I will ensure that my child understands the commitment she/he is making and the importance of self-disciplined behavior at all times during rehearsals and performances.
- ❖ I recognize that Lyrico Youth Choirs is run by volunteers and that the success of the same is based upon the participation and cooperation of all members. I will consider being available to volunteer to help ensure my child has the best choral experience possible.
- ❖ I undertake to pay the Choir membership fees established by the Lyrico Youth Choirs in accordance with the payment policy.

Lyrico Youth Choirs:

As the Lyrico Youth Choirs:

- ✓ We will provide training and instruction in both the theoretical and practical principles of music, with particular emphasis on choral music and its performance. To this end, we will provide highly qualified Directors and Accompanists.
- ✓ We will work to operate a viable and efficient volunteer organization in support of the artistic and educational goals of the choirs.
- ✓ We will update our website; provide newsletters and/or other electronic or printed announcements to ensure adequate communication between Lyrico Youth Choirs and Choir families.
- ✓ We will manage the Choir's financial affairs prudently and diligently. Such management to include; fundraising, applying for government funding grants, as available, and the timely collection of fees.

DRESS CODE

Choristers are required to follow a dress code for all performances. The Directors will inform choristers and parents of specifics prior to each concert. Please read over the following carefully.

CASUAL

Lyrico Youth Choirs will provide a choir t-shirt to all registered choristers which is to be returned at the end of the season or can be purchased for a small price. The choir t-shirt, together with black pants, comprises the casual dress code for all choirs at functions such as school tours.

FORMAL

Certain choir performances during the season will require formal attire. Some items may be provided by the Association and some are to be provided by the chorister. For example, choristers may be asked to wear their own, all-black, dress attire.

If you are unsure, please check with your child's Choir Director for further instruction.

FUNDRAISERS

Registration fees do not cover all costs of the Lyrico Youth Choirs, therefore Lyrico Youth Choirs must rely on **grants** and **special funding** that is applied for throughout the choir year.

Fundraising is another way for Lyrico Youth Choirs to meet the costs of providing high-quality musical programming. Family participation in fundraising helps support the Junior and Senior Choirs while keeping registration fees from carrying the full cost of the program. Please watch choir emails and the website for ordering links, deadlines and pickup details.

Fundraising opportunities this year will include:

- Growing Smiles - poinsettias, holiday wreaths and greenery
- Purdys Chocolates - holiday chocolate fundraiser
- Bottle Drives - fall, winter and spring
- 50/50 Draws - at all three Lyrico concerts
- \$1,000 Raffle - draw at the May concert
- Roadside Clean-up - planned for May 1, 2027

Please watch for more information about these fundraisers as the choir year unfolds. **We rely heavily on the success of each fundraiser when setting the budget for the season. Please support each fundraising campaign to ensure its success.** Thank you so much.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Where do I find information or forms I may need?

Can anybody sing in the choirs?

Both levels of choir are auditioned. Your child must audition for the Director before being allowed to sing with Lyrico Youth Choirs.

Why do I need to give a postdated cheque dated June 1st of the following year for a music deposit fee for SENIOR choir?

We pay a steep fee for all music, and any music we lose must be replaced. Over the past several years there has been an increase of non-returned music, causing us to impose the music deposit fee. Failure to return all of your music will result in your cheque being cashed.

This applies to senior choir only

How is the Choir Association funded?

We are funded through operating grants from various government agencies, concert ticket revenue, fundraising revenue, chorister registration fees, as well as casino funds (every three years).

Will the choirs visit schools or take part in day trips?

Some years, Lyrico choirs visit schools in the area or take part in other day trips. No school tour or day trip is currently planned for the 2026-2027 season, but this may change. Families will be kept updated if an opportunity is added during the year.

Who gets to volunteer? What are the Volunteer opportunities?

This Association depends on volunteers to make it a success. We hope that you will consider volunteering on a regular or as-needed basis, depending on your interests and availability. Please take the time to fill in the back portion of the registration form. All members are invited to volunteer.

Where will the Choir Concerts be located?

Lyrico's three main season concerts, The Gift of Music, The Imagine Concert and The Sounds of Spring, are held at Festival Place, 100 Festival Way, Sherwood Park. Other performances and special events may take place at different venues. Please check the Important Dates section of this handbook, choir emails and the website for current details.

What factors determine where the concerts are held?

Lyrico's main season concerts are currently held at Festival Place. Other performances may be held at different venues depending on the event, availability, acoustics, audience size, accessibility and parking. Families will be given the location and arrival details for each performance in advance.
